A BUNCH OF UN-USUAL SUSPECTS



AMB 160 TRANSPONDERS

All competitors it is your responsibility to ensure that your transponder unit(if owned by you) is fully charged and operational before race day. In accordance with Aka rule 19.17(d) - when a transponder system is in use at race meetings for qualifying and/or lap scoring, it is the driver's responsibility to obtain, fit and correctly use their allocated transponder. Please also ensure that the correct number is on your entry form—if the ladies in the tower don't know who you are you won't get points for the race maybe even the round.

In accordance with the supplementary regulations all transponder units will be in a transponder holder bracket which is to be located facing the driver on the left hand sidepod 300mm from the kingpin. If required transponder holder brackets are available for purchase at the circuit for \$10 each inc GST, all screws and retaining clips included.

The club will hold a small number of spare transponders available in the event of emergency.
